




### From a catalog search, use the search facets to create your desired results.

In this example, I want to create a "New Adult Books" collection spotlight, so I've selected the "Adult" audience, selected the "Book" format filter, and sorted the search results by "Date Purchased Descending."




STEP 2
Scroll to the bottom and click Create Spotlight.






#### STEP 3


# Type in a name for your collection spotlight.


### **Click on Create Spotlight**

### The spotlight is created!


After creating a new spotlight, you'll see a summary of your collection spotlight settings, along with the code snippets you'll need to copy if you wish to embed your spotlights on another website.





# Scroll down to view and copy the embed code.


You'll have two options for embed code: a standard spotlight and a resizable spotlight. This page will also display live previews of each.


